After work, school or activities of the day, we come home to renew and relax in a safe environment. There are so many things on our “to do” list and yet occasionally thoughts creep in whether our home could be safer. The answer is, yes! Eighty percent of injuries and fires will happen in the home. The Home Safety Council has dedicated June as “Home Safety Month”. It is time to answer safety questions you might have, such as:

- Would our family know how to get out of our home safely if there was a fire?
- Would I know how to put out a fire on the stove/oven?
- If I had to use a fire extinguisher, would I know how? Is it charged?
- Do I have enough smoke alarms? Are they in the right place? Are they too old?
- Is there a system of fire protection to keep me safe even when we are not home?
- Am I at risk for a dryer, furnace or chimney fire? Can I prevent these?
- Are there things in my house that would cause falls to happen?
- Is the water temperature of our home safe?
- Is our home truly kid-proof of chemicals and poisons?
- Do I have carbon monoxide, natural gas or radon in my home?

Home Safety Surveys. It is a non-threatening, confidential, room to room check of your home by a firefighter. Your awareness of potential fire, injury or crime hazards that are in your home is heightened. If children are present, a fire drill is done.
